**Major Purpose:**

As a Republican leader, the Neighborhood Activist's (NA) ultimate duty should always be WINNING elections. He or she shall work diligently to elect Republicans and to support elected Republican officials.

The NA is NOT an official member of the Central Committee and focuses their efforts on their immediate neighborhood. They generally would not attend CC meetings.

**Duties:**

- Be the catalyst in your neighborhood (approximately 50 houses) for a variety of Party activities including fund-raising.
- Assist local, state, and national Republican candidates in their campaigns.
- Assist in registering to vote all Republican voters in your neighborhood.
- Lead the Party's organizational efforts in your neighborhood. Raise awareness of the party and Republican candidates at various events throughout the year.
- Assist with the get out the vote (GOTV) efforts in your neighborhood.
- Attend and support the precinct caucus.

**Qualifications: (Skills, Knowledge, Education, Experiences:**

- Must be a Republican and acceptable to the Precinct Committeeperson.
- Should be reasonably responsive to requests for time and effort. (Expect 4-5 hours per month).
- Should be personable. Getting along with people is vitally important in political activity.
